Machigonne Offline for Routine Dry Dock Beginning on February 27th

The Machigonne II will be delivered to the shipyard for a routine dry dock and Coast Guard hull inspection on Monday, February 27th. Depending upon weather and the schedule for repairs, she may be at the yard for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this period of time, as is the customary practice, Lionel Plante Associates will provide vehicle transportation to and from Peaks on a temporary alternative vehicle schedule. **Passenger service will continue to operate on the regular sailing schedule.**

LPA will be running their larger vessel so capacity per trip will also be increased and vehicles will be loaded on a first come, first served basis. Reservations can still be made for commercial vehicles through Casco Bay Lines.
