Spring Schedule Update & Rate Increase

This is a reminder that <u>peak season rates</u> will go into effect on **Saturday**, **April 16**, **2022**. The 2022 Spring Sailing Schedule will also take effect on that date and is available to view <u>here on our website</u>. It will also be posted in the terminal and on the vessels.

Monthly Pass Program Updates

As part of the CBL Frequent Rider Pass program, a Monthly Pass has been available for purchase for unlimited passage during a calendar month. Beginning on May 1, 2022, CBL will instead offer a 30-day Pass in place of the Monthly Pass. The pass can be purchased at any time and used for unlimited passage during the subsequent 30-day period. This change provides frequent riders with more flexibility to utilize the pass in alignment with their schedule. Please continue to visit the ticket window to purchase passes.

Peaks Island Residential Boarding Program

The Peaks Island Residential Boarding Pass pilot program was created in 2021 to ensure space available onboard each trip for passengers that meet the definition of a resident. Pilot program passes issued in 2021 are valid through June 18, 2022, and passholders should hold onto their pass for use this spring. To
