Upcoming Dry Docking for Machigonne II

The Machigonne II will be delivered to the shipyard for a routine dry dock and Coast Guard hull inspection in early February. Depending upon weather and the schedule for repairs, she may be at the yard for approximately 6 to 8 weeks. During this time, as is customary, Lionel Plante Associates (LPA) will provide vehicle transportation to and from Peaks on a temporary alternate vehicle schedule. Passenger service will continue to operate on the regular schedule.
