Machigonne II Going Offline for Dry Dock

Tomorrow, **Thursday, March 28th**, the Machigonne II will be delivered to the shipyard for a routine dry dock and Coast Guard hull inspection.

As you know, we have been anticipating this as part of the 2019 dry dock season. However, we do apologize for the short notice of delivery. This is partly due to the return of the Bay Mist being delayed by weather. The railway is available tomorrow for the Machigonne II and can't be pushed to a later date.

Depending upon weather and the schedule for repairs, it is anticipated she may be at the yard for approximately 5 to 6 weeks. During this period of time, as is the customary practice, Lionel Plante Associates will provide vehicle transportation to and from Peaks on a scheduled, yet limited, basis. We will begin our alternative vehicle service tomorrow, March 28th. Please see below for that schedule. Passenger service will operate on the regular sailing schedule.
