CBL Awarded \$3.4 Million for Terminal Renovations

We welcomed the Acting Administrator of the Federal Transit Administration, K. Jane Williams, to the terminal on Thursday, August 8th. Acting Administrator Williams was joined by Senator Susan Collins, Maine Department of Transportation Commissioner Bruce Van Note, Deputy Maritime Administrator Richard Balzano and representatives from the Casco Bay Island Transit District at a media event where federal support for Casco Bay Lines in the form of a \$3.44 million grant was announced. Funds will be put towards a third phase of terminal renovations to expand existing marine infrastructure and complete outstanding marine repairs. [Read more here!](#)
