Dry Dock Scheduled for Maquoit II

The Maquoit II will be delivered to the shipyard for a routine dry dock and Coast Guard hull inspection in early February. Depending upon weather and the schedule for repairs, she may be at the yard for approximately 6 to 8 weeks.

Utilizing the crane on the Wabanaki, there should be minimal impact to Downbay freight service. However, if you have a large delivery (pallet, lift of lumber, etc), please call the Freight Department ahead of time at (207) 774-7871 x116.
