

## Vehicles Less Than 20 ft



## Who's Affected by the Rate Change?

≤ 20'

If you drive a standard passenger vehicle—car, SUV, minivan, or pickup truck up to a ½-ton (F-150, Silverado 1500, Ram 1500, etc.)—you will **not be affected**. These vehicles are under 20 feet in length. This includes full-size SUVs like the Chevy Suburban. The only exception is if your vehicle has protrusions (bike rack, trailer, building materials, etc.) that extend the total length beyond 20 feet.

20'-21'

If you're a passholder and your vehicle measures between 20 and 21 feet, whether due to a protrusion or because you drive a heavy-duty truck like an F-250/350 crew cab with 8' bed, you remain eligible for a passholder discount at a modestly higher rate. See the rate table on back.

> 20'

If your vehicle exceeds 20 feet (or 21 feet for passholders), you'll pay the length-based rate corresponding to your vehicle's total length, as shown in the table on back. **If your vehicle is in this RED category, please purchase tickets at the freight shed ticket office.**

## Vehicles That Could Be Between 20 ft and 21 ft



**Example of "Standard Vehicle" that would not be eligible for passholder discount because length is greater than 21'**

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Why length-based rates?

Ferry capacity is limited by deck space, not weight. Length-based pricing ensures rates reflect the space each vehicle consumes.

## What about freight charges?

The new rate includes all cargo. No additional freight charges regardless of weight carried.

## Do trailers count toward length?

Yes. Total length includes vehicle plus any trailer, bike rack, ladder rack, or protrusions.

## Can I use my pass for oversized vehicles?

Passholder discounts apply to vehicles up to 21 feet. Vehicles exceeding 21 feet pay standard rates.

## How is length measured?

Staff measure using painted lane markings, tape measure or a measuring wheel. Staff are empowered to resolve any disputes.

# A User's Guide to Casco Bay Line's New Large Vehicle Rate Structure



**Peak Season:** Mid-April - Mid-October

**Off-Peak:** Mid-October - Mid-April

**Width Surcharge:** Vehicles wider than 8' 6" incur an additional 50% surcharge
