

FY 2025 Financial Notes:

For the Month of May 2025

May revenues were below budget by 12% and expenses were below budget by 21%. Compared to May 2024, revenues were 5.5% higher and expenses were 25% lower.

Operating loss for May 2025 was 55% favorable to budget and was favorable to May 2024 by 76%.

Revenue Assessment:

Current Month:

May Operating Revenues of \$603K closed 12% below budget and 5.5% above the same period last fiscal year.

- Scheduled passenger revenues of \$259K were 21.5% below budget and 18% above the same period last year.
- Vehicle revenues of \$109K closed 9% below budget and 9% below the same period last year.
- Freight revenues were \$124K and were 2% above budget and 2% above the same period last year.
- Group sales revenues of \$107K were 2% below budget and 1% above the same period last year.

Year to date (YTD):

YTD Operating Revenues were \$2.4M, 9% below budget and 2% above the same period last fiscal year.

- Scheduled passenger revenues YTD of \$922K were 16% below budget and were ahead 11.5% compared to last fiscal YTD.
- Vehicle revenues YTD of \$706K were lower than budget by 8% and 7% below last fiscal YTD.
- Freight revenues YTD of \$496K were 1.6% above budget and 2.4% ahead of last fiscal YTD.
- Group sales YTD of \$284K closed 1% below budget and 1.5% below the same period last fiscal YTD.

Expense Assessment:

Current Month:

May expenses of \$685K were 21% below budget and 25% below May of last year primarily due to:

- \$393K Personnel expense in May 2025, 12% decrease from budget and 15% decrease from prior year due to May 2024 being a 5-week month and May 2025 being a 4-week month.
- \$10K drydock expense for the Aucocisco in May 2025 compared to budget of \$150K which is a timing difference.
- Fuel expense was below budget by 7% and below May of 2024 by 15%. Rate per gallon is down to \$3.29 compared to \$3.487 last May. 17,375 gallons of diesel were used in May 2025 compared to 19,008 gallons in May 2024 a reduction of 8.6%.

Personnel expenses were 12% below budget due to vacant positions and 15% below May of last year.

Vessel expenses were 54% below budget and 56% below May of last year due to timing of expense compared to budget in May 2025 and drydock expense of \$143K for Maquoit & \$22K for Aucocisco in May 2024 compared to \$10K of expense for Aucocisco in May 2025.

Operations expenses were 24% above budget and 10% above May of last year due to increased legal expense, timing of the audit expense earlier in the year in 2025 and timing of Dues & PUC expense and uniforms expense.

Year to date (YTD):

YTD Expenses were 9% below budget and were 4% above last fiscal YTD.

- Personnel expenses YTD were 6% below budget and 4.5% above last fiscal YTD.
- Vessel maintenance expenses were 17% under budget and 1% above last fiscal YTD.
 - Aucocisco drydock estimated total is \$160k below budget.
 - Maquoit emergency drydock for crack in hull plating. \$33K expense in Feb for port rudder rebuild and replacing the exhaust manifold and injectors.
 - Fuel expense YTD budgeted at \$597K and as of May YTD is at \$588K. Fuel price lock of \$3.29 as of Oct 2024 versus \$3.487 last year.
- Operations expenses were 2% above budget and 19% above last fiscal YTD.
 - Barge subcontracting \$182K this year compared to \$20K last fiscal year.
 - o Audit fee expense earlier in year than in FY2024
- Terminal expenses were 5% below budget and 5% lower than last fiscal YTD.
- Sales expenses YTD were 22% below budget and 15% below last YTD.

Operating Surplus/Loss:

Current Month:

Operating loss of -\$82K was 55% below budget and 76% favorable to the same period last year.

Year to date (YTD):

YTD operating loss of -\$3.9M was 9% favorable to budget and 6% unfavorable to last YTD at -\$3.7M.

Grant Revenues:

\$230K of Grant Revenues were recorded in May compared to budget of \$300K.

Year to date (YTD):

Grant revenues YTD of \$2.5M were 14% below budget and 11% below last fiscal YTD at \$2.8M.

\$148K Surplus compared to \$118K budgeted surplus for the month of May.

Year to date (YTD):

\$1.36M Loss compared to \$1.32M budgeted loss for YTD May.
