VESSEL UPDATE

BATTERY STEELE:

The Battery Steele will be launched at SENESCO Marine on April 6, 2026. There continues to be significant work on commissioning various systems, and sea trials will soon follow. We anticipate her departure for Maine to be on or around June 2nd

USCG INSPECTIONS

Several vessels have the mandatory annual USCG inspections coming due in the next month. The only disruption to service will be on April 10th. There will be no car ferry service to Peaks Island for the 1045 and 1215 departures from Portland.

DRYDOCKS:

Drydocks have been completed for the year.

Down Time:

The Peaks Island transfer bridge suffered a circuit breaker malfunction on Sunday March 29th. MDOT had to overnight a part for repair. Subsequently car ferry service was disrupted, and LPA provided supplemental service on March 30th. Bridge was repaired to full working condition for the 1415 departure from Portland.
